## CB Relationship Managers Report.

- A. Soutar
- 1. Thanks to CAB for being first in the Union to complete the safeguarding review.
- 2. There are now 4 Schools Rugby Managers in post in Lancashire. It would be beneficial for the CB to be introduced to them. They are Ali Watt (Liverpool), Doug Martin (City of Manchester), James Wright (Greater Manchester) and Mark Sutcliffe (Fylde Coast).
- 3. Remit to increase the number of girls playing in the 6-12 year old group in partnership with Jack Leach of Sale Sharks.

# D. Westhead

- 1. Impact 25 (Lead up to the Womens World Cup) Momentum is building. Working at 2 "hotspots" of Liverpool and Manchester with a total of 21 Lancashire clubs.
- 6-12 work. Sale Sharks are working with 6 clubs, Sefton, Collegiate, Trafford MV, Manchester, Broughton Park and TocH. Each delivery plan will be different from club to club.
- 3. Volunteer recruitment fund id live currently, clubs can apply for £500 to run a recruitment event. Only 1 application to date and closing date is 22<sup>nd</sup> November.
- 4. 50-60 applications for the Womens Leadership course from across the North.
- 5. MD I Spivey advises a 44% increase in 12-16 year old Girls registrations.
- 6. CAB need to be able to measure the differential between the number of girls registered and those actually playing.
- 7. Held 2 Impact roadshows at Collegiate and TocH which were well attended with 9 Lancashire clubs there.
- DC & HH met with NOWIRUL to look at supporting some clubs with struggling lower teams. Also discussed Electronic Match cards which NOWIRUL are fine with. Second point was the number of 1<sup>st</sup> XVs who are far too good for those levels, there was no agreement on this.

Discussion on the start date of the season after a letter from Southport. NOWIRUL have taken this point to look at further.

- 9. DW Red Roses visits to Waterloo and Liverpool St Helens. Sarah Beckett and Holly Aitchison respectively.
- 10. DW Facilities Group will be updated at next meeting by Matt Coglan about some projects related to Impact 25.
- 11. BHS There is a lot of emphasis on Womens and Girls rugby at the moment to the potential detriment of the Men and Boys game.
- 12. MD voiced concerns about the new regional board that is being brought in and how much extra work will be put on volunteers to help them.

J Jones – Lancashire Youth Council

- 1. Social media been running about 3 weeks with 23k views, TikTok have over 11k views to help grow rugby from a young persons perspective.
- 2. Filming is being done around several of our clubs.
- 3. Rugby Unlimited Drop gave out 120 balls in Bolton town centre to predominantly 14-18 year old Black and Asian children to take to their schools and get some rugby played.

- 5. Next candidates for the ball drop are Trafford MV and Broughton Park. CAB advised to potentially look a towns with Christmas markets.
