A. Soutar

- 1. MD are the club webinars in the report sent to the clubs? they are shared on social media from the RFU staff it would be good if they could be sent to the county contacts also.
- 2. There is a change of staffing, Chris Hall contract has been extended by a further six months and he will work in the North Midlands. This means Aaron Howarth and Matthew Dent will be supporting Cheshire in the club development role as well as their own current roles. Rugby development is not been hit by the recent number of redundancies.
- 3. Didsbury TocH recent flooding could cause damage but we are a few cannot help with funding due to the club being on a floodplain.
- 4. Garstang pitches have been damaged by heavy flooding and they are currently playing on the 3G pitch at Preston Grasshoppers which they're having to pay for.
- 5. MD are the club webinars in the report sent to the clubs? they are shared on social media from the RFU staff it would be good if they could be sent to the county contacts also.

PD Commented further to the report.

- 1. We have in excess of £100k but at this time of year it looks good before spend starts. MD, PS, KB & HH had a meeting to discuss representative rugby budget. It will not be cheap this season with a Somerset away game and all three squads are looking strong. DC had spoken to Tim Miller about the date of the final who will look at this.
- 2. KB On finance report there is £2k CB funding for the Girls U18s but 17s and 18s is £5.9k. PD this is what we are given from the RFU.

RFU

- 1. DC email sent to all clubs in Lancashire from PD & DC explaining situation of executive bonuses and asking for feedback for a Council meeting at Twickenham on 18th Dec. Two responses received form Tarleton and Rossendale. At the meeting on the 18th it was explained that the bonuses were a retention payment for keeping the executive for 3 seasons after the end of covid. This has been setup with an external consultancy. £1m shared by the executive, the CEO had the larger share. Even if it had been deferred to a profit making season it would still appear in this years accounts.
- 2. The meeting also shared that there were a number of as yet undisclosed new sponsors which is in main part due to the success of the Red Roses.
- 3. Notice of an SGM has been sent to all clubs in the Country. The request for this has been through the Referees Union in a note saying that Council members were keeping the truth from their Constituent Bodies. This is contradicted by the email sent to Lancashire Clubs by PD & DC above.
- 4. PD Bill Sweeney and Tom Ilube needed to better communicate with media. Current media manager is leaving. Many of the Council members did not know of the LTIP Bonus.
- 5. DC leaks to press do not seem to be coming from the Council.
- 6. DC meeting on 10th Jan to ratify Sir Bill Beaumont as interim chair who will outline his vision of the future.
- 7. PD personal view is to stick with what we have. The RFU is essential a not for profit organisation. Monies that it raises are distributed through the game as a whole. This could change with loss of funding if the Union became a profit making business. A new Chairman could potentially rip up the £120m coming to grassroots game over the next three seasons. Council does now have an opportunity to support Bill Sweeney with caveats on communications, and improved relations with Council.

 Getting rid would not be cheap as there is a years salary compensation.

- 8. There is work going on about the CB of the Future. The new regional bodies will be responsible for the growth of the game, the Counties will be responsible for keeping the players we have playing. One controversial issue is for the RFU to pay for CBs to have a paid General Manager. We don't have to do anything as we are an autonomous body and as yet there is no job description.
 - MD who is ultimately employing them? PD is we did decide it would have to someone self employed as we are not as a County employing staff.
 - PD There is £800k available for all CBs over 3 years, a quick calculation would be £25k per annum.
 - MD is unhappy at the time scale for this as all would need to be set up by July which is very short notice for volunteers during the busiest time of the season.

- 2. U20s trial on 12th Jan at PGH.
