CB Relationship Managers Report.

A Soutar

- 1. Schools Rugby Managers There are currently 4 covering Lancashire with a potential of a 5th to be added next season covering the East Lancashire area. The choice of this location is data driven from the RFU Insights team. DC questioned who would be covering the Ormskirk to Warrington area.
- 2. AS to meet Bob Wilkinson (Schools Liason) on 4th March to discuss work of the Schools Rugby Managers.
- 3. D. Westhead has 50 "T1 Flat Packs" of which 16 can be used for Clubs. PD confirmed we have £4k to support Adult Clubs in their T1 offering.

D. Westhead

- 4. Impact 25 14% up on last season so going well. School delivery has started with clubs in the Manchester and Fylde clusters working, a few concerns with Liverpool clubs which is slower.
- 5. T1 Packs Clubs to provide sessions and sign up for Spring / Summer events. 2 off events at clubs in Manchester and Liverpool to introduce "Acquaint" sessions.
- 6. Northern Girls Network (NGN) James Wright and John Foster had met. The NGN had grown very large. Just over 50% of girls attending are registered which will be looked at to improve. These registrations are needed across all age groups.
- 7. Chorley DW asked if anyone had an update on Chorley. DC had spoken to the a few times, they had dropped out of the leagues but were hoping to rebuild.

Minutes of the last meeting.

The minutes of the Board meeting held on Monday 10th February 2025, (previously circulated) were accepted and signed per procurationem as a correct record.

Ouestions to Written Reports

Finance

PD had provided a report – Appendix 1.

- 1. Cash in bank is in a healthy position. A payment is still outstanding to MADREFS.
- 2. Potential to fund an U23s Tournament from the Player Retention funds.
- 3. A commitment to cover costs of T1 packs for Clubs as well as £250-£500 grants for clubs to launch T1.
- 4. £20k still remains in the Rugby United fund to be allocated.

Discipline

BHS Reported:-

- 1. There have now been 198 disciplinary issues this season which will definitely be an increase on last season. In the last 7 days there 6 cases of match official abuse.
- 2. Clubs will be advised of a new process to deal with match official abuse. The club will be given a formal CB warning if it reoccurs again within two seasons they will be sanctioned with points against the 1st XV.
- 3. BHS does not feel that the 20 minute red card system should come into the community game as referees have enough to contend with at that level without the help of assistant referees.
- 4. BHS will present this new process to deal with match official abuse at the upcoming county general meeting.

<u>RFU</u>

DC Reported:-

- 1. There had been a council meeting during February.
- 2. DC had asked a bujalski about how to submit proxy votes for the upcoming special general meeting of the RFU he was to respond.
- 3. All their items within the council meeting were deemed confidential.
- 4. There was discussion on how the CB would vote on the two resolutions at the upcoming are a few special general meeting. Directors who were present at the board meeting voted

- unanimously to support bill Sweeney against the SGM resolution calling for his removal. There was also a unanimous vote to support the second resolution regarding the new governance process.
- 5. HH felt that many club administrators were out of touch with what the players within the game and their clubs wanted.

At this point BHS left the meeting

6. PD - The new regional bodies we're progressing slowly and should be in place by July.

Mens & Boys Rugby.

HH Reported

- 1. Pete Taylor had confirmed that there were lots of development courses planned for over the closed season during the summer.
- 2. Under 17s Manager four applications have been received for the post so far.
- 3. Under 20s the Northumberland game would be played at panic the Ladies XV will be playing the same day at Morpeth.
- 4. Electronic match cards for county games will be used going forwards. There had been some technical issues trialling this with the under 20s that need to be resolved based on eligibility of players.

Womens and Girls.

1. Trials have been announced for the Senior Women's XV squad.

Website.

1. MD reported on a virtual meeting that had been held with members of the board and Jonathan Conn, the IT director from the RFU along with two representatives from the first sport. This was to discuss the possibility of using first GMS as a background for a County website. Lancashire will potentially be the first to use this process. The county will provide a website map that we feel would be most suitable. The RFU and First Sport will respond once received.

Cluster Meetings.

1. MD and PD had arranged 5 club cluster meetings with chairman and secretaries. The coasters were based on league level and not geographical location as this was felt that clubs would have more in common to discuss. The two main agenda points for the cluster

meetings were the expansion of T1 rugby and the formation of the new regional bodies. There would also be scope for open discussion to listen to clubs needs.
